# Holy Week at Woodridge . . . April 14-21 - a week to prepare for the hope of the resurrection

#### Palm Sunday (April 14) @ 10 am:

We start Holy Week with a children and youth led Palm Sunday processional as we celebrate Jesus triumphant entrance into Jerusalem. Full Sunday school to follow the passing of the peace - fellowship & refreshments to follow.

#### Maundy or Holy Thursday (April 18) @ 7 pm:

Our Holy Week preparation will continue as we celebrate the Last Supper with communion; washing of hands; and a reading of Jesus arrest, trial and crucifixion.

#### Good Friday (April 19): 9 - 6 pm:

Our sanctuary will be open for private reflection and devotion - including an opportunity to reflect on our Lent/ Holy Week art exhibit.

#### Easter (April 21) @ 6 and 10 am:

Our Easter celebration will begin at 6 am with a brief service outside the sanctuary and a hot breakfast to follow in fellowship hall. Our 10 am service will be full of special music, including the Hallelujah chorus, a time with children, and an Easter message.

#### Lenten Mission Project – continuing through Sunday, April 28

As our congregation prepares for Easter Sunday, we traditionally ask our community to participate in a Lenten mission project. This year we are collecting diapers, underwear and socks --all sizes-- for foster care children. Families who provide temporary or long-term homes for foster children often struggle to meet the cost of providing these items because they are not provided nor do families get fully reimbursed for them. Our collection will relieve some of the burden on these families and help them continue to provide for the children who need it most. Collection boxes are located outside of the sanctuary and in fellowship hall.
