On the second Sunday of Advent - our theme will be "**peace**." The children's message, sermon, readings and music will be centered on this theme.

Worship on December 22 will feature the **Children's Pageant**. Rehearsals and speaking parts will be worked on during Sunday School class time; all children who attend church December 22 can be part of the pageant but must come by 9:30 am to be fitted for a costume.

On Christmas Eve, services will be offered at 5 pm and 11 pm:

- **5 pm** Family service a Christmas message, carols, a reading of the Christmas Story and candle lighting
- **11 pm** Candlelight service of lessons and carols including communion
