### From the pastor's desk ... 4 things for your consideration ...

**Financial commitments/ pledges to the church - 2019 budget:** If you are planning to make a pledge, please do so as soon as possible. This is important for 2 reasons. One, it helps with our planning for 2019. And two, it saves a few people a lot of work in making follow up calls. Thank you for your consideration and continued support.

**Sermon series:** October 28 through November 18, I am doing a sermon series on "healing." The premise is that we are all in need of healing - whether it be physical, relational, emotional, or spiritual. And that God is the source of all healing. Different scripture lessons will help us explore our need for healing and the healing power of God.

Sunday school coordinator position & hiring: We are looking for a Sunday school coordinator to work 6 hours/ week for \$20/ hour. The position begins as soon as we can hire someone and follows the school year (or approximately 44 weeks/ year). This person will work about 3 hours on Sunday morning arranging classrooms, supporting teachers, finding helpers, and meeting parents. The other hours will be flexible and used to prepare for Sunday mornings. Previous experience is not required but we are looking for someone who is comfortable with the Christian faith. We are open to both someone from the Woodridge community or someone not currently part of our community.
