After many weeks of preparation,

on September 6. This has replaced worship
over Zoom, but a recorded worship service

the church website. It is important to know

and should only come if you are comfortable
and are feeling well. In addition, we want to
encourage those who are vulnerable to
Covid 19 because of age or compromised

health to please consider watching the service from home. Our service is shorter (around 45 minutes) with a simpler format that will be easy for all ages to follow along.

Music is shared on a screen and by piano and organ. There will be an opportunity to share prayer concerns and celebrations in person as we always do. The rest of the service should be familiar. To assist us in maintaining proper distancing and overall attendance numbers, you will need to make a reservation (by contacting the church office) and masks are required.
